Important Rules

- This study plan is designed for students starting the ACE program in the academic year 2024/2025.
- Interested students are required to read and understand the study plan and its rules. These are to be considered binding to the successful completion of the triple degree program.
- The list of courses may be subject to changes should the academic offer at Renmin University, George Washington University or Luiss be amended.
- The listed exams must be taken and passed in the academic year indicated in the scheme (not after). Any possible change must be formally authorized by the Academic Commission.
- During the mobility, students will be subject to the rules of RUC (third year) and GW (fourth year) for all matters related to their academic life.
- Regarding transfer of credits to GW, students must obtain a grade of 21/30 or higher at Luiss and a grade of C- or higher at RUC to receive transfer credit for the course.
- At the end of the program, if compliant with both all academic requirements, students will obtain three degrees:
 - Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration by Luiss
 - Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration by RUC
 - Bachelor of Science Degree in Business/International Business by GW

Final Work

- Students are required to complete their final work / theses during their fourth year at GW.
- Students must respect the thesis procedures and deadlines from all institutions. Each institution will grade the final thesis according to its own standards.
- Each supervisor has to approve the proposal specific to that supervisor's institution, with the proposals also being different products that must meet the standards of the respective institutions.
- Students are reminded that they are required to comply with the Luiss regular procedure regarding the thesis assignment, registration for the degree exam and upload of the thesis. For further information, please check the [following page](#).
